Who is this course for?

Anyone working with **young people** (aged 11 to 25) who are either using or experiencing Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) e.g. violence against a girlfriend/boyfriend/other intimate partner.

Please note: this course does not address young people's use of violence towards parents/other family members. DVIP offers this training separately.

What does the course cover?

- How and why young people are using/experiencing violence and abuse in their intimate relationships
- The impact of violence/abuse on young people, how is it different from IPV in adult relationships
- What are the challenges of working with young people using/experiencing violence and abuse?
- Having conversations with young people about violence/abuse
 - Challenging abusive behaviour and supporting change
 - Supporting safe choices and realistic safety planning
- Working safely: bridging the gap between young people and services
- Case studies*
